You are invited to participate in the writing of an interdisciplinary collective monograph:

The monograph will cover the following areas:

- Law and Legal Studies
- Economics
- Public Administration and Governance
- National Security. Information Security
- Engineering, Technology, and Technical Sciences
- Philosophy, Political Science, Sociology
- Ecology and Natural Sciences
- Pedagogical and Psychological Sciences
- Culture and Arts
- Social Communications
- Medicine. Healthcare. Social Work

The monograph will be assigned an **International Standard Book Number (ISBN) of Poland**.

All monograph materials will:

- Be reviewed by professional editorial boards;
- Be assigned a **Digital Object Identifier (DOI)**;
- Be included in the **ResearchGate** scientific network, which has over 1.5 million users from 192 countries;
- Be indexed in **Google Scholar, CrossRef**, and other scientometric databases;
- Have **permanent open-access storage**;
- Be published on the **E-SCIENCE SPACE** website and the websites of project partners.

Authors will receive a **ready-for-print original layout of the monograph**.

This is a unique opportunity to contribute and become co-authors of collective monographs alongside leading experts from various scientific fields in Ukraine and worldwide!

We also draw your attention to the fact that, in addition to participating in the writing of a collective monograph on a relevant topic, there is an opportunity to publish an individual monograph or the research results of an authorial team separately.

In the case of a **personal monograph order**, it will be published on the relevant websites within **10 days** from the date of its acceptance by the editorial board for publication.

The monograph will be published by a **European publishing house (Poland)** and assigned an **ISBN number**. Additionally, mandatory distribution of its copies is provided, allowing authors to participate in a collective scientific work published in a **European Union country**.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ELECTRONIC VERSION OF THE PUBLICATION

To ensure the high quality and proper formatting of the monograph, all submitted materials must comply with the following requirements:

1. General Formatting:

- File format: **Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx)**
- Page format: **A4 (210×297 mm)**
- Margins: **2 cm on all sides**
- Font: **Times New Roman, 14 pt**
- Line spacing: **1.5**
- Paragraph indentation: **1.25 cm**
- Alignment: **Justified**
- Page numbering: **Bottom center (starting from the first page)**

2. Structure of the Manuscript:

- Title (in English and original language, if different)
- Author(s) full name(s) (in English and original language)
- Affiliation(s), city, country
- ORCID
- Abstract (150–250 words, in English and original language)
- Keywords (5–7 words)
- Main text (divided into sections, including Introduction, Methodology, Results, Discussion, Conclusion)
- References (formatted according to APA, IEEE, or Chicago style, depending on the field of study)

3. Tables and Figures:

- **Tables** should be inserted into the text, numbered sequentially (e.g., Table 1), and have a descriptive title.
- **Figures and images** must be high-resolution (at least **300 dpi**), numbered (e.g., Figure 1), and accompanied by a caption.
- **Graphs and charts** should be editable, preferably created in Microsoft Excel or Word.

4. Citation and References:

- All references must be cited in the text using **in-text citations** (e.g., (Smith, 2020)) and listed at the end of the manuscript.
- References must be formatted according to internationally recognized standards (e.g., **APA**)
- Self-citation should not exceed **20% of the total references**.

5. Language and Style:

- The manuscript must be written in **academic English** (or another language agreed upon with the editorial team).
- The text must be **grammatically correct and well-structured**.
- The use of **machine translation is not allowed**—authors are responsible for proofreading their submissions.

6. Plagiarism and Originality:

- The manuscript must be **original and unpublished**.
- All submissions will be checked using **plagiarism detection software**. The similarity index must not exceed **15%**.

7. Submission and Review Process:

- The manuscript must be submitted via email info@e-science.space.
- The editorial board reserves the right to **reject manuscripts** that do not meet the requirements or request **revisions**.
- Authors will receive **confirmation of acceptance** and, if necessary, suggestions for corrections.

Failure to comply with these requirements may result in **delays in publication or rejection**.

The authors of the collective monograph retain exclusive copyright to the materials submitted to the organizers for the preparation of the collective monograph.
